<b>Math</b>
Review multiplication facts— <a href="https://www.multiplication.com/">https://www.multiplication.com/</a> This is a simple exercise but very critical. Flashcards are a great way to learn facts.
<b>Reading</b>
Students can read books, magazines, short stories, poetry, and newspapers. Students should read a <i>minimum</i> of 30 minutes a day.
