2025-2026 Tuition & Fees for K-8



The full operating cost of Vista Ridge Academy is not covered exclusively by tuition, but rather through a combination of tuition and additional support from our Seventh-day Adventist constituent churches--Boulder Adventist Church (boulder.church) and Chapel Haven Adventist Church (chapelhavenchurch.org). The total cost to educate a student in Colorado is \$11,080. The numbers listed below are the costs to you as a result of the yearly contributions of these churches.

• Registration Fees are non-refundable.

Monthly Payments

- Monthly payments will be made through our FACTS management system (credit card fees may apply).
- Tuition paid monthly is billed July December and February May.
- Registration fees for the following year will automatically be billed in January (the tuition-free month).

Tuition Discounts

- A discount of \$300 is given to students who pay the entire year in advance.
- A discount of \$100, per semester, is given to students who pay the entire semester in advance for a total of \$200.
- Multi-student discounts: \$225 per child for households with 2+ students enrolled.

Financial Aid

- Limited financial assistance is available each year directly from Vista Ridge Academy, which is based on established need.
- If students qualify and receive Financial Aid from Vista Ridge Academy, pre-pay tuition discounts will not apply to payment plans.
- Ace Scholarship. Families must qualify for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program to be considered for this scholarship.
- Church assistance. Some churches provide tuition assistance to eligible members. Please contact your church pastor for more information.
- Partnering for Eternity (PFE). Vista Ridge Academy is able to offer the PFE program for a maximum of 14 students in grades K-8. Participating PFE students are eligible to receive up to \$120 per month credit towards tuition.
